



I-20 EXTENSION REQUEST

An F-1 student who is admitted for duration of status is not required to apply for extension of stay as long as the student is maintaining status and making normal progress toward completion of his or her educational objective. An F-1 student who is currently maintaining status and making normal progress toward completing his or her educational objective, but who is unable to complete his or her course of study by the program end date on the Form I-20, must apply prior to the program end date for a program extension. Delays caused by academic probation or suspension are not acceptable reasons for program extensions.

Please provide a copy of a financial document in which the amount must equal to \$44,964. If student wishes to extend one semester, financial document must show \$22,482.
